- ▶ **The Submission agreement includes the process for submitting the citation to your work and/or the content and brief explanation of the author and creator's copyright.**

Submission Instructions

The purpose of *Opus: Research & Creativity at IPFW* is to

- document the bibliographic record of your scholarly and creative work; and
- archive, if at all possible, the content of your work.

Please read and follow the instructions below to submit a citation to *Librarian Publications* for your published, created, performed, produced work. You will be notified by e-mail when your entry has been added to *Opus: Research & Creativity at IPFW*.

Before you begin, please be sure you have the following items:

- A complete citation for your published, presented, created, performed work
- An abstract of 250 words or less
- A list of keywords (10 maximum)
- The electronic format of your file or hyperlink to your file, if any

The submission process consists of the following steps:

- Read and accept the Submission Agreement below,
- Fill out the Submit Research form
- Upload your electronic file and any associated files, if any

Author Rights to Submit Your Work

You are highly encouraged, but not required, to upload a digital copy of your work at this time.

At the time you create a work of scholarship or creativity, you simultaneously become its copyright holder.

Authors/creators at IPFW own the rights to their works of scholarship and creativity unless they have given those rights in writing to another party.

© If you did not sign a copyright agreement or assignment of copyright for this work, you may upload your work at this time.

© If you signed a copyright agreement or assignment of copyright for this work, you may still be able to deposit your work into *Opus: Research & Creativity at IPFW*,

- © if your copyright agreement allows you, as author, to retain your right to make the work available in digital form over the Internet through your institution's digital repository, or;
- © if your publisher has adopted a policy of allowing its authors to deposit their work on an institutional repository. To find out what your publisher allows please visit SHERPA – RoMEO (<http://www.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>)
